How to flip-out and start having fun

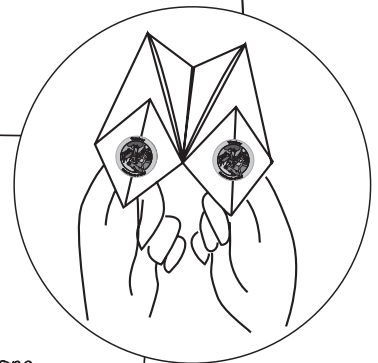


To make flip-out

- 1 Cut along the dotted lines of the flip-out template.
- 2 With the flip-out template facing down, fold paper diagonally so that corners match exactly. Crease fold. Unfold and repeat the process, matching opposite diagonal corners.
- 3 Open paper. Keep template facing down. Fold each corner to centre and crease to form a small square.
- 4 Turn small square over and fold each corner into centre again. Crease.
- 5 Fold square in half top to bottom so that the pockets face out. Crease and open. Repeat this from side to side.
- 6 To open and hold, push your thumbs and first fingers into the pockets.
- 7 Find a few flip-out friends and you're ready to play!

To flip-out

- 1 Have a friend pick a word . Spell the word opening and closing the flip-out in alternating directions as you say each letter.
- 2 At the last letter, keep the flip-out open. Have a friend pick a number from those shown. Count out that number, opening and closing the flip-out as before.
- 3 Finally, you choose one last number. Flip-out the flap and complete the task. Record the points you earn for each task successfully completed.
- 4 Do this until everyone has had at least four turns. Tally score to find the winner.
